<u>Passport</u>. Please check your passport. It should NOT expire within 6 months of returning to the United States. If it does expire before that date, then please immediately renew your passport.

VISA. VISA's may be obtained in advance from the embassies, we recommend on obtaining your VISA on arrival and adhering to all relative processes and procedures prior to departure.
